



Visa Requirements For Mexico

All foreign nationals holding a valid passport and a valid visa from The United States of America (US Visa) are exempted of applying for a Mexican visa.

No visa is required when visiting Mexican ports while on a cruise, for a maximum of three days on each stop over. If the stay exceeds the period of three days, a visa is required.

Applicants are to apply in person at the Embassy of Mexico.

South African passport holders require a visa for Tourism and Business purposes.

REQUIREMENTS

- Visa application form dully completed and signed
- Passport with at least one year of validity and two blank pages.
- 2 recent colour passport photos. (white background, not wearing eyeglasses)
- Letter of employment, stating duties and monthly income
- Proof of financial resources (copy of 3 months bank statements). This is regardless of the company covering all expenses.

Business

- A letter from a Mexican company, stating the purpose of the visit and length of stay.
